

The MOTA museums are conveniently located near the 134 and 110 freeways in Pasadena and Los Angeles.

The **Gamble House** and **Pasadena Museum of History** are located off the Ventura 134 freeway on either side of Orange Grove Blvd. at Walnut Avenue. The **Los Angeles Police Museum** is located south of the 134 freeway; take Figueroa St. to York Blvd. and then travel west. The **South Pasadena Historical Museum** is on Meridian Avenue, just south of Mission Street.

The other two Los Angeles museums are located north of downtown Los Angeles off the 110 freeway at the Avenue 43 exit. **Lummis Home** is within walking distance to **Heritage Square**.

A Line (Gold) Connections

Consider taking Metro to MOTA Day; the A Line (Gold) has a stop at **Heritage Square** and the **South Pasadena** stop is very close to the South Pasadena Historical Museum.

Parking

Parking is available on surface streets around each museum; there is limited parking at the **Los Angeles Police Museum's** parking lot.

There is **NO PARKING** on Homer St. or the adjacent dirt lot near **Heritage Square**; the museum has a back gate at 3515 Pasadena Avenue and visitors can park nearby, have rideshares drop off/pick up and use that entrance.

Shuttles

Shuttles will stop at **all museums except Heritage Square**; visitors must take a short walk from **Lummis Home** to get to **Heritage Square**.

Shuttles will run in one continuous loop: from **The Gamble House/Pasadena Museum of History** → **South Pasadena Historical Museum** → **Los Angeles Police Museum** → **Lummis Home/Heritage Square** → returning to **The Gamble House/Pasadena Museum of History**.
